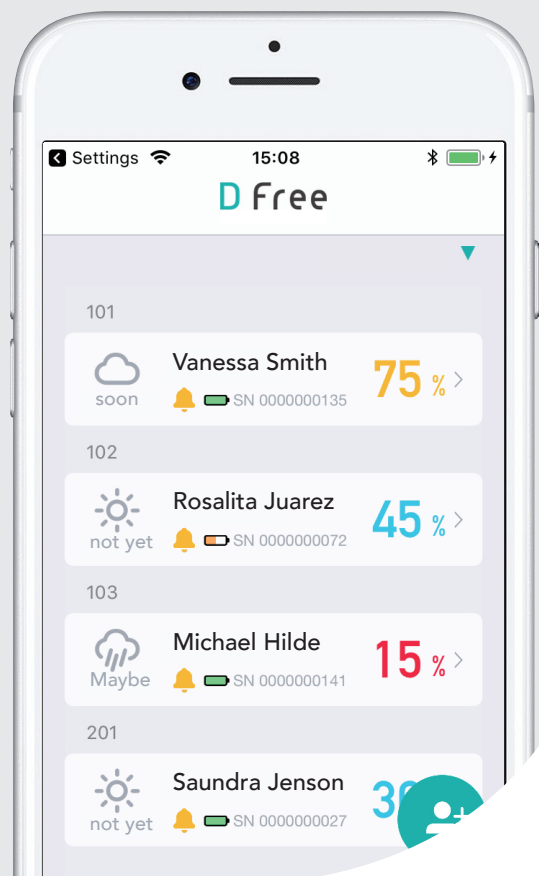

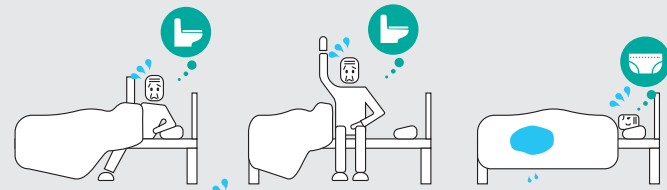
What is it?

DFree® is a non-invasive wearable device that monitors the bladder and sends notifications when you need to go to the bathroom.

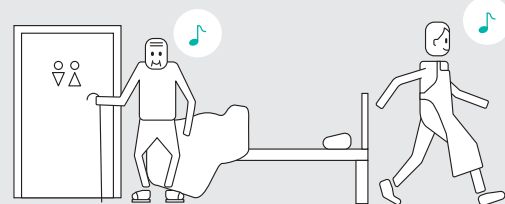
There are many factors that can cause concerns about the ability to avoid accidents and get to the bathroom on time, especially for seniors.

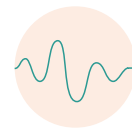
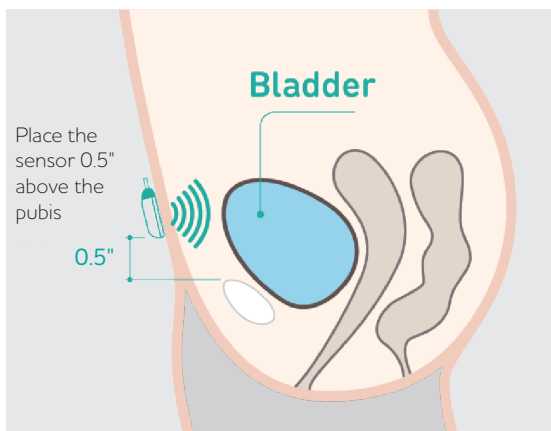
Lower consumption of diapers

How it works

DFree monitors the bladder, predicts when your bladder is full, and sends alerts to go to the bathroom.



1 Safe and non-invasive

DFree uses a harmless and non-invasive ultrasound sensor to monitor the bladder.



2 Easy to use

Bladder indicator light will change color when the sensor is placed in the right location.

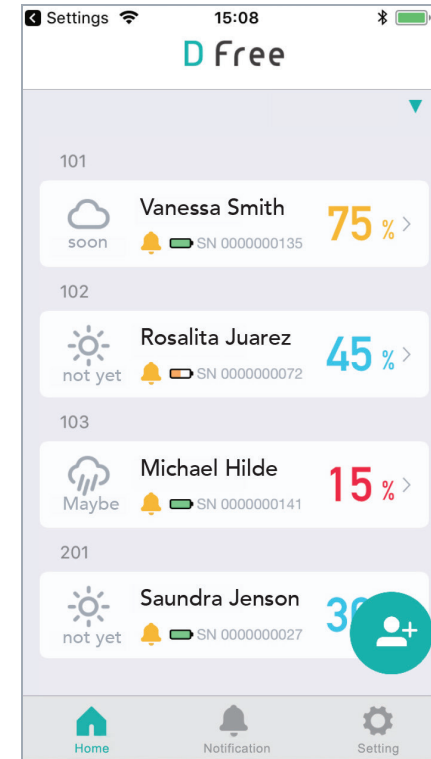


3 All the data in one place

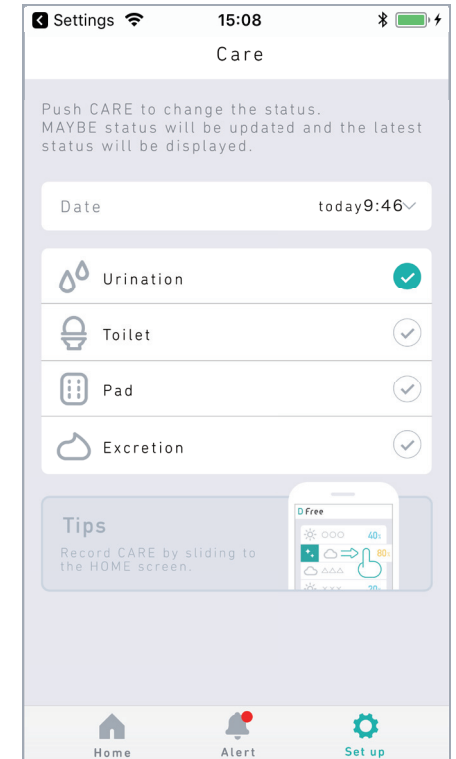
Track multiple patients
